

Words About Worship From the Director of Music Ministries



Oh my goodness! It seems like school was just out yesterday and June and July have already flown by! Several schools will already have begun classes by the time you read this article. With the heat we are experiencing, I am more thankful than ever that we have air conditioned schools and a cool place to worship!

Jonathon is continuing his messages from the Revised Common lectionary in August. August 4 is John 6:24-35. Ella McDonald is singing *Goodness of God* in the 11am service. The Scripture for August 11 is Ephesians 4:25-5:2. Spirit Singers are singing *Leaning on the Everlasting Arms*. August 18 reading is 1 Kings 2:10-12; 3:3-14. The Choir will return to worship (yay!) singing *A Faithfulness Medley*. August 25 is Pumpkin Sunday! Pull out your Pumpkin Shirt, or wear something fall-ish. The scripture reading is Psalm 84. 


All hands are needed Thursday, August 1st for TEFAP!
