# Words About Worship From the Director of Music Ministries



Can you believe that it's only 3 weeks until Christmas?! Yikes! Many thanks to the faithful helpers who decorated our church home for the season! There is a sense of expectation in the air. Company is coming! Our "house" is prepared, now we need to prepare our hearts for the coming of the Messiah. Please plan to worship with us in person if you are able. If not, online worship continues on Facebook live and on Youtube.

A guick refresher course — Advent is a form of the Latin word that means "arrival or to come." The colors of Advent are purple and blue. These colors denote royalty because in ancient times the dyes to make these colors were very rare and prohibitively expensive. Only the very rich could afford them. As we begin worship each Sunday, a St Matthew family will light the Advent candles. There is one candle for each of the four Sundays, Hope, Peace, Joy and Love. The Chrismon tree is decorated with gold balls and our Chrismons. The word Chrismon is a combination of Christ and monograms. They have symbols, or monograms of the Christian faith, cross stitched on them. The lights on the trees and Communion rail remind us that Jesus is the light of the world.

There are many opportunities for worship during Advent. Last Sunday, we celebrated Holy Communion in both services, and lit the Candle of Hope. December 8 is the Candle of Peace, scripture reading is Luke 3:1-6, December 15 is the Candle of Joy and, the scripture is Philippians 4:4-7, December 22 is the Candle of Love. The scripture in the 8:30 service is Luke 1:46b-55. December 22 during the 11am service, the Chancel Choir and Spirit Singers will present our Christmas Cantata, This Child, Immanuel. The drama will feature members of our St. Matthew Youth, directed by Kalyn Roark.

December 24, Christmas Eve, we will have two services. The 6pm Christmas Eve Service will feature our Children's Christmas Program, "Crazy, Busy, Peaceful Holy Night" .The program will replace the sermon for this service. Special music will be provided by Chancel Choir, Great Is Our Joy! Jonathon will light the Christ Candle and Chelsea Luxen will end the service with O Holy Night. This service is designed for children, so it will be informal. This is an excellent time to invite family and friends to join you!

The second Christmas Eve service is the 11pm Christmas Eve Candlelight Communion. This service features Carols and Scripture, Tilt Your Candle by the Spirit Singers, O Holy Night sung by Stacey Ruston, and Holy Communion. The service ends with lighting our individual candles and singing Silent Night. If you have never attended this service, please make this a new part of your Christmas tradition, and bring someone with you. If you desire, pjs for kiddos are not only allowed, but encouraged.

December 29 is the official Christmas Sunday. The scripture is Colossians 3:12-17. We will still sing Christmas carols and the Spirit Singers will sing Gotta Whisper, Gotta Shout! End your 2024 the right way with your church family!


